- Workplace health and safety (WHS) requirements relating to servicing, diagnosing and repairing air conditioning and HVAC systems
- · Handling, storing and transporting refrigerant cylinders and recovery cylinders
- · Diagnostic testing procedures for air conditioning and HVAC systems

Licencing

To attend this course, participants will need to apply for an ARCtick trainee licence (Classroom) CL000.

Upon successful completion of the course, participants will be provided with a statement of attainment listing the completed units. It is the responsibility of the participant to provide their statement of attainment to ARCtick in order to obtain an AAC02 - Refrigerant handling licence.
